The Commission on the Status of Women,

Reaffirming the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action¹ and the outcomes of its reviews, the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women,² the outcome documents of the twenty-third special session of the General Assembly,³ the Programme of Action of the International Conference on Population and Development,⁴ the key actions for its further implementation⁵ and the outcomes of its reviews, the Convention on the Rights of the Child,⁶ the Declaration on the Elimination of Violence against Women,⁷ the 2021 Political Declaration on HIV and AIDS: Ending Inequalities and Getting on Track to End AIDS by 2030,⁸ Security Council resolution [1325 \(2000\)](#) of 31 October 2000 on women and peace

and security and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development,⁹ including the Sustainable Development Goals, in particular the resolve of Member States to end the AIDS epidemic by 2030, as well as its resolutions 60/2 of 24 March 2016, 62/2 of 23 March 2018 and 64/2 of 2 July 2020 on women, the girl child and HIV and AIDS,

1. *Takes note* of the report of the Secretary-General, submitted pursuant to its resolution 64/2;¹⁰

2. *Reiterates* the continued resolve to achieve the commitments made in resolution 60/2, and urges Member States to accelerate their implementation;

3. *Requests* the Secretary-General to submit a progress report on the implementation of the present resolution to the Commission on the Status of Women at its sixty-eighth session.
