In the immediate aftermath of the earthquake, we did our utmost to swiftly provide all assistance possible to help alleviate the suffering in all affected regions. The European Commission and the Swedish Presidency have taken the initiative to host a Donors' Conference to mobilise funds from the international community in support of the people of Türkiye and Syria in Brussels in March.

We stand ready to further step up our support in close coordination with the Turkish authorities. Our thoughts will continue to be with you and your people.
