on the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on establishing a framework for interoperability between EU information systems (borders and visa) and amending Council Decision 2004/512/EC, Regulation (EC)No 767/2008, Council Decision 2008/633/JHA, Regulation (EU) 2016/399 and Regulation (EU) 2017/2226 /Council Code 15119/17, COM(2017)793 final/ and

on the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on establishing a framework for interoperability between EU information systems (police and judicial cooperation, asylum and migration) /Council Code 15729/17, COM(2017)794 final/.

The respective documents were included in the agenda of the 8th session of the Committee for European Affairs and were scrutinized on 14th March 2018. According to the Rules of Procedure of the Chamber of Deputies the Deputy Minister of Culture was present at the session to introduce the preliminary Government's Framework Position.

After the hearing of the rapporteur's review and after the discussion the Committee has adopted the resolution No. 44 **in the context of the Political Dialogue** which is enclosed to this letter.

Conclusions of the Resolution:

Committee for European Affairs

1. **takes into account** the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on establishing a framework for interoperability between EU information systems (borders and visa) and amending Council Decision 2004/512/EC, Regulation (EC)No 767/2008, Council Decision 2008/633/JHA, Regulation (EU) 2016/399 and Regulation (EU) 2017/2226 / Council Code 15119/17, COM(2017)793 final/ and the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on establishing a framework for interoperability between EU information systems (police and judicial cooperation, asylum and migration) /Council Code 15729/17, COM(2017)794 final/;
2. **agrees** with the Government's Framework Position on these documents;
3. **welcomes** the interconnection of EU information systems in the area of justice and home affairs;
4. **calls on** emphasis to be placed on the protection of personal data in the case of people's records;
5. **requests the Government** to inform it about the further development of the negotiation of these documents;
6. **authorizes** the Chairman of the Committee for European Affairs to forward this resolution to the President of the European Commission **in the context of the Political Dialogue.**
