The Senate

I.

- 1. Supports** the Government's position on the package for the revision of the Multiannual Financial Framework 2021-2027;
- 2. Considers it a priority**
 - a) to establish the Ukraine Facility for the period 2024-2027 with a total proposed allocation of EUR 50 billion in current prices;
 - b) in view of the current situation, to increase funding in Heading 4 - Migration and Border Management, provided that the increase in this area is duly justified and that part of the new funding is also used to assist EU Member States hosting persons fleeing Ukraine with temporary protection;

II.

1. **Requests** the Government to inform the Senate no later than on 31st January 2024 about the way this Resolution was taken into account and about the further development of negotiations;
2. **Authorises** the President of the Senate to forward this Resolution to the European Commission.
