RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE

Delivered on the 17th session held on 15th August 2018

on the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on promoting fairness and transparency for business users of online intermediation services (Senate Print No. N131/11; COM(2017) 238)

The Senate

I.

1. Welcomes,

in general, efforts to develop a comprehensive approach to modifying the relations of providers of online intermediation services with their business partners across EU Member States;

2. Supports

the Position of the Government of the Czech Republic on this document, especially in connection with a number of technical comments raised by the Government of the Czech Republic on the proposal and with which the Senate identifies;

3. Recommends

to exclude the search engine services from the Regulation, because their function and character differ considerably from other online intermediation services;

II.

1. Requests

the Government to inform the Senate about the way this Resolution was taken into account and about further development of negotiations once the political agreement of the required number of Member States on the main elements of the Proposal is reached, or at an earlier time, should the results of negotiations in the Council begin to depart considerably from the position of the Czech Republic expressed in the General Position of the Government;

2. Authorises

the President of the Senate to forward this Resolution to the European Commission.
