## 28th Session on 15 May 2019

### Reflection Paper Towards a sustainable Europe by 2030; 5953/19, COM (2019) 22 final

### **Conclusions of the Resolution:**

Committee for European Affairs

- 1. **discussed** the Reflection Paper Towards a sustainable Europe by 2030; 5953/19, COM (2019) 22 final;
- 2. **takes into account** the resolution of the Committee on Environment on this document from its 18th Meeting from 3 April 2019;
- 3. **notes** that the Reflection Paper is presented too late to become a basis for a broader societal debate on the transition to a sustainable Europe by 2030, given the societal seriousness of the topics discussed;
- 4. warns against the increasing of the EU's climate change objectives, including the respect of the fact that it is very difficult to enforce these objectives at global level;
- 5. **supports** the Government's Framework Position of the Czech Republic on this Reflection Paper, in particular the Government's specific position on individual substantive proposals;
- 6. **appreciates** the detailed justification for the Czech Government's Position on the important strategies and legislation referred to in the Reflection Paper;
- 7. **requests** the Government of the Czech Republic to proceed restrained and to take into account the sustainability of Czech industry and Czech agriculture, the competitiveness of the Czech Republic and in particular societal implications of this direction;, in its further negotiations on the direction to a sustainable Europe (and of course also for a sustainable Czech Republic);
- 8. **authorizes** the Chairman of the Committee for European Affairs to forward this resolution to the President of the European Commission in the context of the Political Dialogue.
- 9. **forwards** this resolution to the Committee on Environment for information;
- 10. **forwards** the Reflection Paper Towards a sustainable Europe by 2030, including the Government's Framework Position and its resolution to the Committee on Environment for information.
