I assume you must feel at home in this parliamentary environment, given your impressive history and experience in the Italian Parliament and government and your extensive knowledge of parliamentary law. Mr President – the relationship between your country and our Parliament indeed is strong. As you undoubtedly know, both our countries were part of the Inner Six, those who signed the Treaty of Paris, creating the European Coal and Steel Community on the 18th of April 1951.
